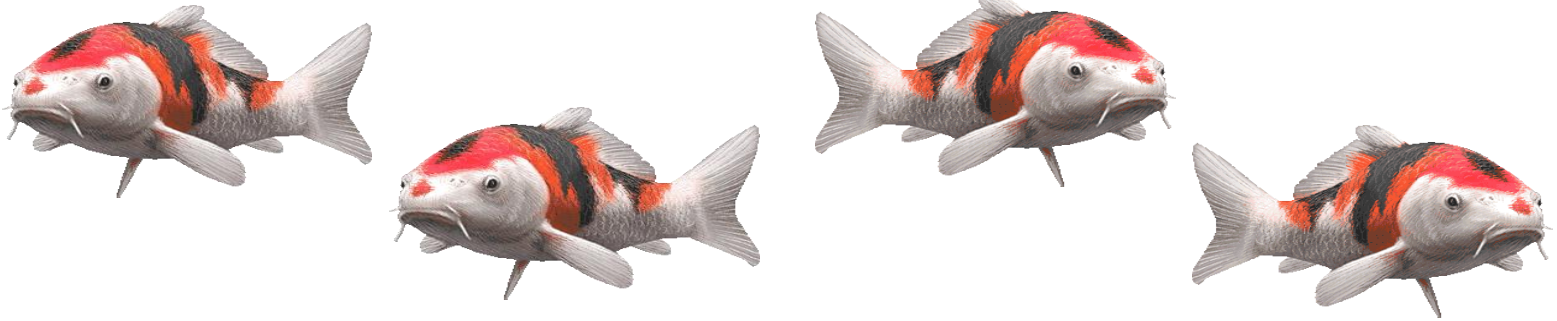

## Acclimating Your New Koi

### The Following Steps Will Take 45 Minutes

- **Open the bag by undoing the elastic band trying not to break the band.**
- **For Large Koi over 12" in length, placing the Koi and bag water into a clean and well rinsed bucket may make Ion cooler the next few steps easier.**
- **Add pond water equal to 1/3 of the total volume of water in the Koi's Bag to the bag, reseal with the elastic band, and leave the bag floating in the pond.**
- **Repeat the above step 2 more times waiting 15 minutes between each addition of pond water to the bag.**
- **After the 3<sup>rd</sup> addition of water to the bag, wait 15 minutes and then net the koi from bag and place it in the pond. Do not add any bag water to your pond.**
- **Remove the now filled bag from the pond and discard the water. Again never release bag water directly into the pond.**
- **At this point adding a stress reduction product to the pond, such as Pond Detoxifier will help ease the stress of the newly acclimated koi along with any koi currently in your pond.**
